

TERMS OF USE

www.unirent.in

1. GENERAL

- a) This document is an electronic record in terms of Information Technology Act, 2000 and rules there under as applicable and the amended provisions pertaining to electronic records in various statutes as amended by the Information Technology Act, 2000. This electronic record is generated by a computer system and does not require any physical or digital signatures.
- b) This document is published in accordance with the provisions of Rule 3 (1) of the Information Technology (Intermediaries guidelines) Rules, 2011 that require publishing the rules and regulations, privacy policy and Terms of Use for access or usage of www.unirent.in
- c) The domain name www.unirent.in ("**Website**"), including its online services, such as use of software on Website and information, articles , news, blogs and text, graphics, images and information obtained from service providers and any other material contained on the ("**Website**"), is owned and operated by **UNIRENT TECHNOLOGIES PRIVATE LIMITED** ("**Company**") a Private Company limited by shares, incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 having its registered office at A-5, Jai Ganesh CHS, Tukaram Nagar, Avre Road, Dombivali (East), Thane District- 421201, Mumbai, India where such expression shall, unless repugnant to the context thereof, be deemed to include its respective representatives, administrators, employees, directors, officers, agents and their successors and assigns.
- d) For the purpose of these Terms of Use ("**Terms**"), wherever the context so requires,
 - i) The term '**You**' or "**User**" shall mean any legal person or entity accessing using this Website to services provided or registered on this Website, who is competent to enter into binding contracts, as per the provisions of the Indian Contract Act, 1872;

- ii) The terms **‘We’, ‘Us’ & ‘Our’** shall mean the Website and/or the Company, as the context so requires.
 - iii) The terms **‘Party’ & ‘Parties’** shall respectively be used to refer to the User and the Company individually and collectively, as the context so requires.
- e) The headings of each section in these Terms are only for the purpose of organizing the various provisions under these Terms in an orderly manner, and shall not be used by either Party to interpret the provisions contained herein in any manner. Further, it is specifically agreed to by the Parties that the headings shall have no legal or contractual value.
- f) The use of the Website by the user is solely governed by these Terms as well as the Privacy Policy (**“Policy”**), available on Website and any modifications or amendments made thereto by the Company from time to time, at its sole discretion. Visiting the home page of the Website and/or using any of the services provided on the Website shall be deemed to signify the User’s unequivocal acceptance of these Terms and the aforementioned Policy, and the User expressly agrees to be bound by the same. In so far as the User complies with these Terms, he/she is granted a personal, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable, limited privilege to enter and use the Website.

Unirent takes the responsibility of marketing and popularizing the site through different means as found feasible. The Company caters to different business functions through individual websites. Unirent is in B2C space and caters to individuals sprinting between the home and the workplace and run out of charge while it is in the midway. The website is an online platform that enables you to charge your phone or tablets through portable powerbanks which are ready to be rented at any time.

3. ELIGIBILITY

The User represents and warrants that he/she is competent and eligible to enter into legally binding agreements and that he/she has the requisite authority to bind himself/herself to these Terms, as determined solely by the

provisions of the Indian Contract Act, 1872. The User may not use this Website if he/she is not competent to contract under the Indian Contract Act, 1872, or is disqualified from doing so by any other applicable law, rule or regulation currently in force.

4. TERM

These Terms shall continue to form a valid and binding contract between the Parties, and shall continue to be in full force and effect until:

- c) You agree and acknowledge that www.unirent.in control any transactions on the website. Accordingly, the contract of on the website shall be a strictly bipartite contract between you and the Unirent on www.unirent.in;

Whichever is longer? The Parties agree that certain portions of these Terms shall continue to remain in full force and effect indefinitely, even after the expiry or termination of these Terms as contemplated herein.

5. TERMINATION

The User agrees and acknowledges that it may take up to seven (7) business days for the Company to give effect to such a request by the User.

The User expressly agrees that notwithstanding anything contained hereinabove, he/she may be contacted by the Company or any of its affiliates / partners relating to any service availed of by the User on the Website or anything pursuant thereto.

It is expressly agreed to by the Parties that any information shared by the User with the Company shall be governed by the Policy.

7. CHARGES & PAYMENT

- a) Payments for the Services/Goods offered by Unirent shall be made through Net Banking, Cash, Credit card, Debit card, Net banking.
- b) Unirent offer no guarantees whatsoever for the accuracy or timeliness of the refunds reaching the Users card/bank accounts.
- c) GST on all the above components shall be charge separately.
- d) Unirent have a right to hold or reclaim the Payment in cases of abuse, fraud or violation of agreement.

8. TERMS, CONDITIONS AND DUTIES OF THE USER

- a. It is the duty of User to provide true/accurate / complete information about its, and all the details relating thereof.
- b. The User agrees to comply with all notices or instructions given by Unirent from time to time to enable the use of the Services.
- c. It is the duty of the User to handle the rental product with utmost care and return after use at the Unirent Box only.

- d. The User agrees that the for the rental product the rent will be charged according to rates mentioned in the website at the time of booking.
- e. The User agrees that in case of any mishandling with the powerbank or rental product then he/she should inform about the same to the Unirent Partner at the Unirent Box as soon as possible.
- f. The User agrees that the Unirent shall be permitted to charge for any damage or misplacement of the Powerbank/ rental product by the User.
- g. The User agrees that in case of any damage (including but not limited to dent, scratches, breakage, chipping, cracked cover, exposure to liquid or dampness or moisture or sand, hardware and software bending of Product frame, modifications, unauthorized repairs, tampering of the Product or any other cause not arising due to manufacturing defect of the Product) of the Rental Product, shall be liable to pay on the existing market value of the Product, at the time of such damage. In case the product is lost (including but not limited to robbery, theft, misplacement) by the User, the User shall intimate Unirent immediately about the same and the User shall either file a first information report (“FIR”) with the jurisdictional police station and share the copy with Unirent or shall assist Unirent in filing the FIR. The User shall be liable to pay a penalty amounting to the existing market value of the Product, at the time of such incident. Unirent has all the right to recover the lost product cost as per the current market value from User.
- h. The User understands and agrees that User is responsible for all applicable taxes and for all costs that are incurred in using the websites services.
- i. The User shall promptly make the payment to Unirent towards the rented product as and when it becomes payable.
- j. User shall indemnify and hold the Company, harmless for any loss or damage arising out of User’s to comply with any applicable laws or

regulations and for breach of the following warranties and representations.

- k. The User shall at all times during the pendency of this agreement endeavour to protect and promote the interest of the Company and ensure that there will be no damage to third party (client/customer) due to act/ omission on the part of the User.
- l. User is bound not to cut, copy, distribute, modify, recreate, reverse engineer, distribute, disseminate post, publish or create derivative works from, transfer, or sell any information or software obtained from the Website. - d)** Duty of company not to mislead the description of the product and describe actual condition of the product.

- e) The Company may, in its sole discretion and at any time update, change, suspend, make improvements to or discontinue any aspect of the Services, temporarily or permanently.
- f) The Company reserves the right to inspect the Product delivered to the User during the final pick up of the Rental Product at the end of the term or earlier termination (as the case may be). The User shall cooperate with the Unirent to carry out the necessary quality checks of the Product at the time of pickup of the Product. Unirent shall provide a quality check report to the User, in case any damage is found to the Product at the time of reverse pickup, the User shall be liable to pay for such damage.
- g) Any individual residing in India and of legal age as defined by constitution of India is a potential client for Unirent.
- h) UNIRENT TECHNOLOGIES PRIVATE LIMITED grants you a limited license to access and make personal use of this website, but not to download (other than page caching) or modify it, or any portion of it, except with express written consent of UNIRENT TECHNOLOGIES PRIVATE LIMITED and / or its affiliates, as may be applicable.
- i) Unirent and / or its business partners shall at all times during the term of this Agreement, retain title to and / or be the beneficial owners of the Products delivered to the User, pursuant to the Agreement. 10. RETURN, CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

Return Policy:

The User is to be aware that he/she should handle the powerbank with utmost care and return it safely. Damaged powerbank will not be accepted. If any damage is been caused to the powerbank then the user will be liable to pay for the same to the company. Any fraud claim or doubtful return will not

be accepted.

User can complaint about Unirent Partner or any issue related products to our customer support or email (**Complain@Unirent.in**)

Cancellation Policy:

Once booking is confirmed and payment is made by the User for the rental product then if User wants to cancel one's booking then within 5 min by logging in to Unirent one can cancel the booking. The user needs to be aware that the whole cancellation process should be done by the User within 5 min. After the prescribed time period (5min) passed User will not be able to cancel/refund amount paid against the services.

Refund Policy:

As soon as User's booking gets cancelled, User can claim refund on refund@unirent.in. Unirent will initiate a refund, which can take 7 business days to reflect in User's account.

11. SUSPENSION OF USER ACCESS AND ACTIVITY

Any or all kind of communication relating to any dispute or grievance experienced by the User may be communicated to the Company by the User reducing the same to writing, and sending the same to the registered office of the Company by Registered Post Acknowledgement Due / Speed Post Acknowledgement Due (**RPAD / SPAD**).

18. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- a) **Entire Agreement:** These Terms, read with the Policy form the complete and final contract between the User and the Company with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all other communications, representations and agreements (whether oral, written or otherwise) relating thereto.
- b) **Waiver:** The failure of either Party at any time to require performance of any provision of these Terms shall in no manner affect such Party's right at a later time to enforce the same. No waiver by either Party of any breach of these Terms, whether by conduct or otherwise, in any one or more instances, shall be deemed to be or construed as a further or continuing waiver of any such breach, or a waiver of any other breach of these Terms.
- c) **Severability:** If any provision/clause of these Terms is held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable by any court or authority of competent jurisdiction, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions/clauses of these Terms shall in no way be affected or impaired

thereby, and each such provision /clause of these Terms shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law. In such case, these Terms shall be reformed to the minimum extent necessary to correct any invalidity, illegality or unenforceability, while preserving to the maximum extent the original rights, intentions and commercial expectations of the Parties hereto, as expressed herein.
